

Noise of such character, intensity, & duration as to be detrimental to the life or health of any individual is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited too unreasonable noise from vehicles, parties & animals.

Daytime & Evening Hours: 8:00 am to 10:00 pm

Noise should not exceed the moderate level of background music and normal conversation (60 d.B)

Nighttime Hours: 10:00 pm to 8:00 am

Noise and amplified noise should not exceed the levels at any point beyond the boundary of the property from which the sound emanates (50 d.B) unless authorized by a permitted issued under the Town Code, State, or Federal Authority.

Violation Notices & Fines

After three founded investigatory complaints, the violator may receive a Violation Notice including a \$50 fine. Payments must be made within 30 days.
