
Bridging the Gap will host its monthly food distribution on March 15th. Distribution will begin at 9:00 am and end around noon. Food is given on a first come, first serve basis.

## CODE ENFORCEMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

*Reminder pertaining to Code of Ordinance § 93.15 and Code of Ordinance § 93.41* The existence of any of the following on any lot or parcel of land constitutes a nuisance to the public health which may result in a fine.(Code of Ordinance § 93.15)

- Weeds and grass excessive in height to exceed 8 inches.
- Accumulation of car parts, construction materials, household items
- Accumulations of animal or vegetation matter

**Reminder to Residents:** Bulk/brush, trash cans and basketball goals should not remain at the roadway. Proper arrangements should be made before placing bulk or brush at the roadway. Trash bins should not be placed at the road more than 48 hours before pickup, and should be removed within 48 hours after pickup. Basketball goals should be moved back when not in active use. (Code of Ordinance § 93.41)
