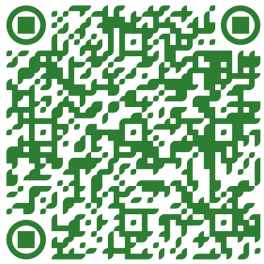

CODE ENFORCEMENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

Prohibited Discharge

To prevent clogged drains, local flooding and contamination of the town and state waterways, we encourage residents to refrain from disposing of pollutants in the storm water drainage system (including associated curbs, gutters, ditches, or swales). Pollutants include but are not limited to abandoned yard waste (grass clipping and debris), refuse, litter, accumulation, and hazardous substances.

(Code of Ordinances Section § 50.55)

Open Storage

The existence and presence of accumulated storage or placement of unusable or inactively used appliances, furniture, building materials and tires, human-made items, and/or junk, is an open storage violation prohibited according to the Town's Community Appearance Ordinance.

Grass Clippings

For the safety of motorcyclists please do not blow grass clipping in the roadway.
